We need to understand why fatherhood is such a big deal from a spiritual perspective; it will _____ your life.


Satan's biggest strike against God was to damage His place as the Father of us all. His whole strategy is one of division. Jesus came to bring us to restoration with God our Father.

*For this reason I bow my knees to the **Father** of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the **whole family** in heaven and earth is named. Eph. 3:14-15*

*For [the Spirit which] you have now received [is] not a spirit of slavery to put you once more in bondage to fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption [the Spirit producing sonship] in [the bliss of] which we cry, **Abba (Father)! Father!** The Spirit Himself [thus] testifies together with our own spirit, [assuring us] that we are children of God. And if we are [His] children, **then we are [His] heirs also: heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ [sharing His inheritance with Him]**; only we must share His suffering if we are to share His glory. Romans 8:15-17 Amplified*

There is no English word that adequately conveys the meaning of the Aramaic word, "Abba." This is why the translators gave us this transliteration "Abba." **The word conveys a close intimacy that is reserved for parents and children.**

Receiving God as your Father requires you to accept His personhood, which redefines us to a place of having the status as "the beloved."
